When the select grape stock is placed in the earth, great wine begins. The resulting vintage is a reflection of the soil, water, temperature variation, wind, and light - or as we say –“the terroir.” The volcanic rhyolite soils of LDV estate were created from the layers of ash deposited by the Turkey Creek Volcano eruption 27 million years ago. The vineyards, located along the banks of Ash Creek in the Chiricahua Mountain foothills, are destined to produce an interesting range of wines as our knowledge of the unique qualities of the estate develops.



All hand-crafted wines are the expression of the grapes grown in a specific year. LDV estate vines are nourished through sustainable practices to ensure quality and consistency, while at the same time protecting precious natural resources.

Our vines are minimally handled and traditionally groomed. We have the terroir to produce outstanding grapes and it is our responsibility to provide the platform for the plants to succeed with little interference.
