



WINES & VINES

LDV Winery is in the heart of the fast growing Arizona wine country. Located in the Chiricahua Mountain region, our 40-acre estate has currently 13 acres under cultivation with room to grow.

We focus on Rhone varietal grapes that include Petite Sirah, Syrah, Grenache, and Viognier. We believe the terroir of the Chiricahua Mountain region of southeastern Arizona will produce fine wines that reflect this special environment.



LDV is in complete control of the grape growing and winemaking processes. Our grapes are grown, and wines produced with very little manipulation. Our wines have not been made using chemical additives (other than minimal SO₂), flavor or color enhancers, enzymes, or animal products. Therefore, LDV wines are gluten free and vegan with zero residual sugar (except for our dessert wines). LDV uses about a third of the industry average of sulfites (SO₂) to ensure the wines remain stable and age beautifully. LDV wines are low carb, paleo, and keto friendly.



The winery houses our modern winemaking operation and tasting room. The building includes temperature-controlled cool room where cold soaking and fermentation take place as well as barrel and bottle aging and storage of finished wines. The winery also includes a work area for our equipment, sanitation facilities, and wine laboratory.

The 1,600 foot covered crush pad provides shade for grape crushing and processing and is the site of informal wine celebrations. The entire facility is handicapped accessible and can accommodate tastings and wine-themed events for groups from 15-100.



Curt Dunham is the winemaker and Peggy Fiandaca brings LDV Winery wines to the marketplace and makes the experience accessible and interactive for wine lovers.

If you cannot visit the vineyard and winery, we have brought a piece of the vineyard to Old Town Scottsdale with our Tasting Room in the heart of the thriving entertainment district. In the Tasting Room you can taste and purchase LDV wines and enjoy a glass of wine on the patio in the midst of a lot of activity.
